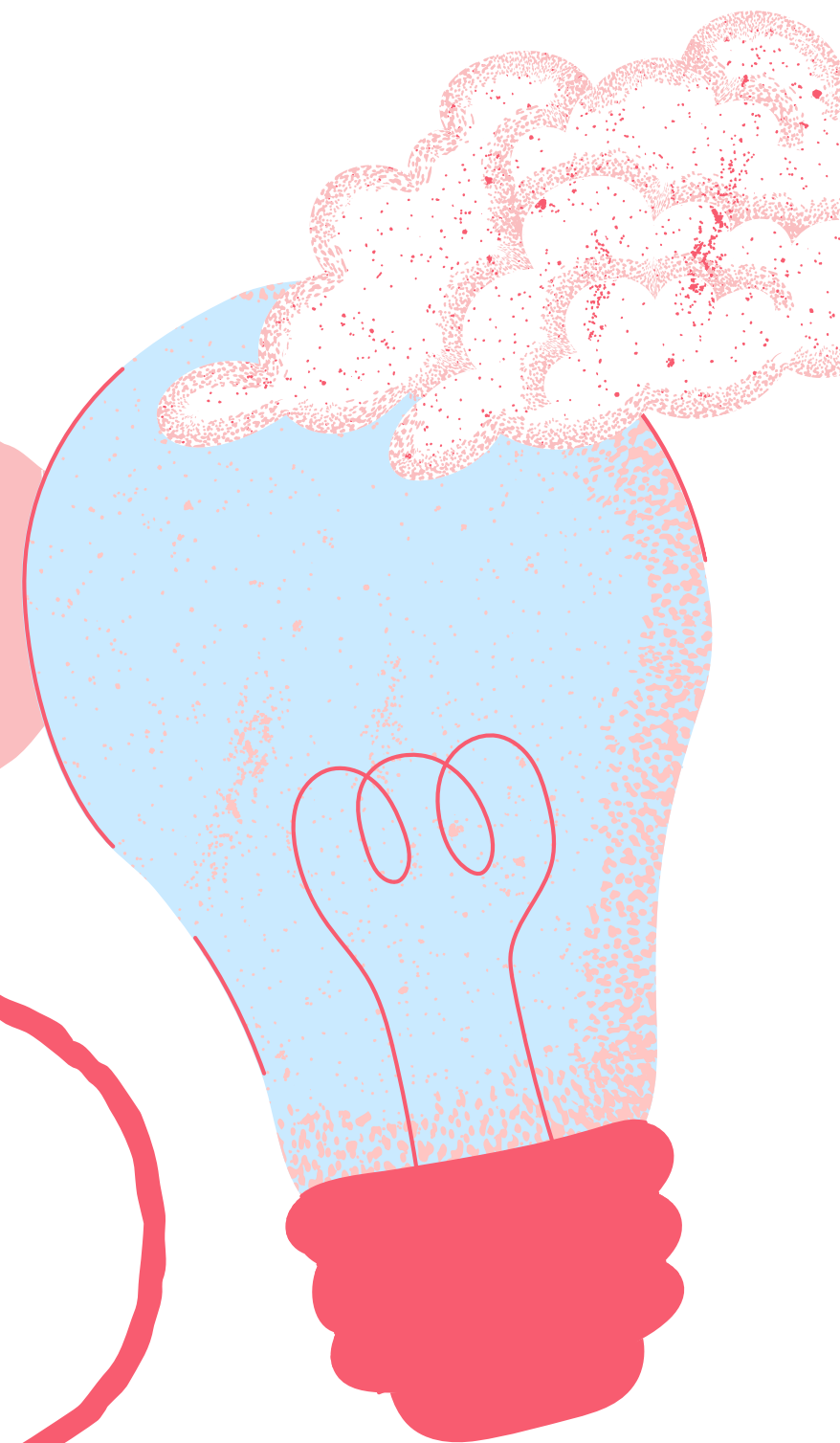


# GRAD APPLICATION DO'S AND DON'TS

DO remember that a graduate application is an introduction to the field; DON't send in a shotty application



DO start looking into application requirements ahead of time and make a concise list of schools you would like to apply to months before the due dates

DO make sure the school can provide funding and make sure there is MORE THAN ONE specialist there you would like to work with

DO make sure your application shows some depth! BUT DO NOT make yourself look too niche or narrow in the scope of your interest. DO make sure your research interests align with the Uni's faculty's research interests and resources.

DO NOT compare applying to grad school to your undergrad applications. DO NOT just go by the universities name and assume it will have the resources you need; DO make sure your application shows some depth
